- コース終了は Day 12 の研究発表後になりますが、Day 13 (9 月 8 日) のゴールドコースト空港までのお送りは、特別な場合を除き午前 7 時 30 分までにゴールドコースト空港へ到着するよう AJWCEF が行います (ホテルー空港間は車で約 10 分)。
